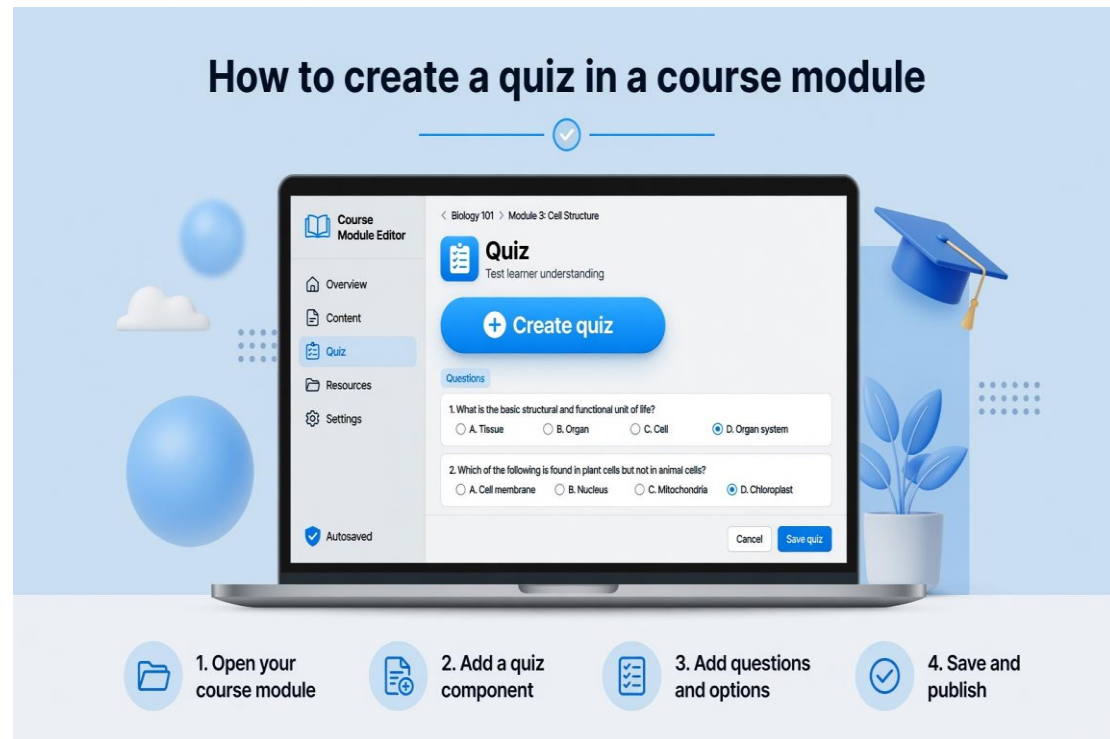


How to create a quiz in a course module



Quizzes are a great way to test your students' knowledge and keep them engaged. On systeme.io you can easily add a quiz to any module of your course.

Here is a clear step-by-step guide to create one.

1. Open your course

Log in to your systeme.io account. Go to the **Assets** menu → **Courses**, then click on the course you want to edit.

2. Select the module and create the quiz

Open the module where you want to add the quiz. Click the three dots next to the module name and choose **Create a quiz for this module**.

A confirmation popup will appear — click **Confirm**.

The quiz editor will open.

3. Add questions and answers

Click the **Add a question** button.

For each question you can:

- Write the question text
- Add several answer options
- Mark the correct answer(s)

You can add as many questions as you need. The interface is simple and lets you build a complete quiz in just a few minutes.

4. Save the quiz

Once you have added all your questions, save the quiz. It will now be available to students inside that module.

Students will be able to take the quiz when they reach the module, and they will usually see their results immediately after submitting.

Tips for better quizzes

- Keep questions clear and focused on the module content
- Use a mix of easy and more challenging questions
- You can create quizzes in several modules of the same course

Quizzes work with every access type available on systeme.io (Full access, Drip content, Partial access, etc.).
