How Automated PayPal Payouts Work

Once your payment system has been configured, affiliate commissions follow a structured workflow. Eligible commissions are calculated, validated and prepared before being transferred through PayPal according to your payout schedule.

Typical payout process

1. An affiliate generates an eligible sale.
2. The commission is recorded.
3. The validation period is completed.
4. The commission becomes eligible for payment.
5. PayPal processes the payout.
6. The affiliate receives the commission.

Before You Begin

Before enabling automated PayPal payouts, make sure all required accounts and payment information are properly configured.

- An active PayPal Business account.
- A configured affiliate program.
- Verified payment information.
- Sufficient available funds.
- Approved affiliate commissions ready for payment.

Review your payment settings carefully before processing your first automated payout cycle.

Configure Your Payment Settings

Open your affiliate payout settings and select PayPal as your preferred payment provider. Verify that your PayPal account is correctly linked and that every required authorization has been completed.

Once the connection has been established successfully, future eligible payouts can follow your configured payment workflow with minimal manual intervention.
