

# How to Get a Free Migration to **systeme.io**



## Introduction

Moving from ClickFunnels, Kajabi, GoHighLevel, or another stack can feel overwhelming—funnels, courses, lists, and automations do not move themselves. [systeme.io](#) offers a **free, done-for-you business migration** when you are on the right plan (help article **2010**).

This guide covers **eligibility**, **what is included**, **how to request migration**, and **realistic timelines**—so you can switch platforms without rebuilding everything alone.

## What Is the Free Migration Service?

The **systeme.io migration team** transfers your existing business assets into your new account: products, sales pages, funnels, email lists, customer data, sequences, and more ( [free-migration page](#) ).

- **No separate migration invoice**—the service is bundled with eligible plans

- **Manual, quality-focused rebuild** in the systeme.io editor (not a blind one-click import)
- **No forced downtime**—your old platform can stay live while work happens in systeme.io
- You **cancel old tools only after** you confirm the new setup works

Content is recreated within your **plan limits** (contacts, courses, funnels, etc.)—see [pricing](#) when choosing Startup vs Webinar vs Unlimited.

## Who Qualifies?

Per official help **2010** and migration articles **2360** / **2385**, free migration is available if you subscribe to:

- **Unlimited monthly plan** (\$97/month), **or**
- **Any annual plan** (Startup, Webinar, or Unlimited billed yearly)

The **Free plan** and **monthly Startup/Webinar** (without annual billing) do **not** include this perk on the pricing perks table—upgrade first, then open your migration ticket.

You can start on [systeme.io](#) free to explore, but **request migration only after** you are on Unlimited monthly or an annual subscription.

## What Gets Migrated?

Depending on your plan limits, the migration typically includes (2010):

- **Importing contacts** (with tags where possible)
- **Migrating sales funnel pages** and landing pages
- **Migrating blogs and articles**
- **Migrating courses** (modules, lessons, structure)
- **Transferring emails and campaigns**
- **Migrating automation** rules and sequences

Platform-specific guides add detail—for example [ClickFunnels → systeme.io \(2360\)](#) and [GoHighLevel → systeme.io \(2385\)](#).

**Not automatic:** domain DNS, payment processor keys, and third-party integrations—you will still connect Stripe, authenticate your domain, and test checkout after migration ( [316](#)).

## 3 Steps to Request Your Free Migration

## Step 1 — Subscribe to an eligible plan

In **Settings** → **My plan**, upgrade to **Unlimited (monthly)** or choose **annual billing** on Startup, Webinar, or Unlimited ( [1509](#)).

## Step 2 — Contact support

After your subscription is active, open [systeme.io support](#) and ask for **free migration**. Support forwards your request to the **migration team** (2010).

Be ready to share:

- Current platform (e.g. ClickFunnels, Kajabi, GHL)
- Account email on systeme.io
- Exports, screenshots, or **read-only access** where appropriate
- List of funnels, courses, and automations to prioritize

## Step 3 — Review timeline and approve go-live

An agent analyzes scope and gives an **estimated completion date**. When pages and automations are ready, **test payments, emails, and member access** before you point your domain and cancel legacy tools.

# How Long Does Migration Take?

FAQ in help **2010**:

- **Wait time** depends on request volume, number of pages, and complexity—content is migrated **manually**
- **Average duration**: about **17 days**, but simple projects can be faster and large multi-course businesses slower

The public migration page notes smaller moves may land in roughly **2–5 business days**, while complex stacks can run **1–2 weeks** or more—always use the estimate from **your** assigned agent.

Plan a **parallel run**: keep selling on the old system until systeme.io funnels and automations are verified.

## DIY Import vs. Free Migration

### DIY (CSV + rebuild)

You import contacts via CSV and

### Free migration team

Team imports and organizes lists

tags

You recreate every funnel page

You rewrite automations

Lower cost, more hours from you

Team rebuilds pages in the editor

Team duplicates automation logic

Included with eligible plan, longer queue

For a small list and one funnel, DIY may be enough ( [import contacts guide](#)).  
For a full business clone, the **2010** service is the intended path.

## After Migration: Launch Checklist

- ☐ Authenticate domain for email ([316](#))
- ☐ Connect Stripe / payment method
- ☐ Send a test campaign to a small segment
- ☐ Open a course as a test student
- ☐ Update DNS to point domain to systeme.io
- ☐ Pause or cancel old platform subscription

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Who qualifies for free migration?

**Unlimited monthly** or **any annual** systeme.io plan (2010).

### What is migrated?

Contacts, funnel pages, blogs, courses, emails/campaigns, and automations—within plan caps.

### How do I start?

Eligible plan → [contact support](#) → migration team takes over.

### How long?

~**17 days** average; varies with complexity and queue (2010).

### Cancel old platform first?

**No**—stay live until you validate the new setup (free-migration page).
