

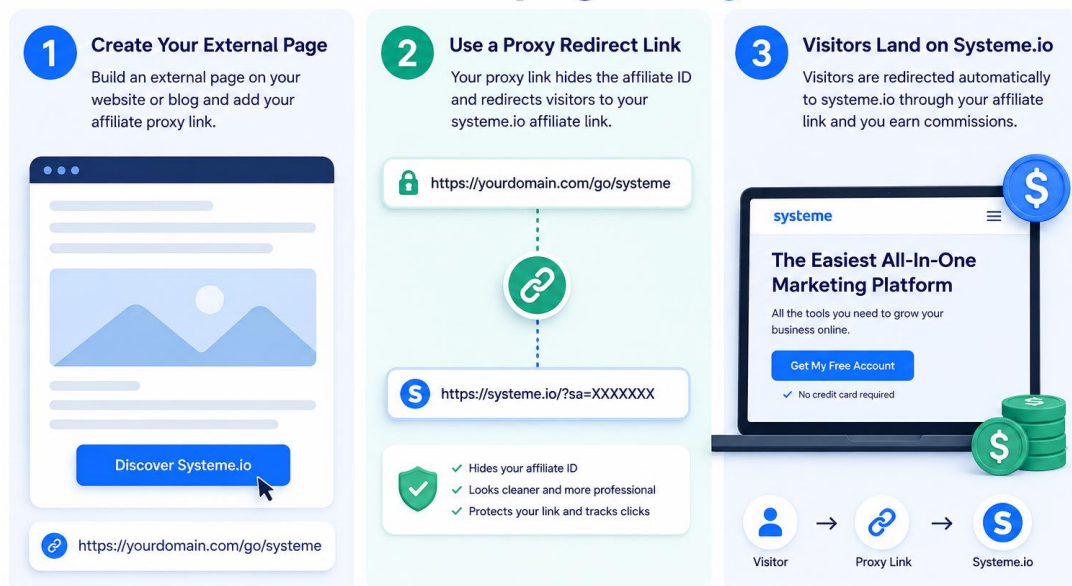
How to Create an Affiliate Proxy Link with an External Page to Systeme.io

Introduction

Affiliate proxy links allow you to promote products or services from an external website while still benefiting from affiliate tracking. Instead of sending visitors directly to your affiliate link, you can first direct them to your own website, blog, landing page or other online content before they continue to the final destination.

When used correctly, affiliate proxy links provide a cleaner user experience, strengthen your branding and help you better organize your marketing campaigns. They are especially useful for content creators, bloggers and businesses that want to recommend [Systeme.io](https://systeme.io) through their own website.

How to create an affiliate proxy link with an external page to systeme.io



Quick Explanation

A proxy affiliate link works as an intermediate step between your visitor and the final destination. Instead of exposing a long affiliate URL, your audience first visits your external page before being redirected to the affiliate offer.

Simple workflow:

1. Create an external page on your own website.
2. Add your affiliate proxy link.
3. Visitors click your page.
4. They are redirected to the final destination.
5. Eligible affiliate tracking continues automatically.

Why Use an Affiliate Proxy Link?

Proxy links offer several advantages compared to sharing long affiliate URLs directly. They make your promotions look more professional while allowing visitors to interact with your own content before reaching the affiliate offer.

A proxy page also gives you the opportunity to explain the benefits of a product, answer common questions and build trust before visitors click your affiliate link.

- Present additional information before the redirect.
- Organize multiple affiliate campaigns more efficiently.

Prepare Your External Page

Before creating your proxy link, prepare the page that visitors will see first. This can be a blog article, review page, tutorial, landing page or resource page hosted on your own website.

The page should clearly explain the value of the product you recommend and naturally encourage visitors to continue toward the affiliate offer.

Tip

Educational content usually converts better than simple advertisements. Helping visitors solve a problem first often produces higher conversion rates.

Configure Your Proxy Link

Once your external page is ready, create the proxy link and connect it to the destination page you want visitors to reach.

If you promote [Systeme.io](https://systeme.io/), your proxy link should ultimately redirect visitors to your affiliate URL while preserving proper tracking.

Visitors never need to remember the long affiliate URL because your proxy page handles the transition for them.

This strategy often improves visitor engagement, increases trust and may contribute to better conversion rates over time.

Best Practices for Proxy Links

Creating a proxy link is only the first step. To achieve the best results, combine it with valuable content that answers your visitors' questions before asking them to click your affiliate link.

- Create helpful tutorials instead of simple advertisements.
- Explain the benefits of the product before adding your affiliate link.
- Use clear call-to-action buttons.
- Regularly test your proxy links to verify that every redirect works correctly.
- Keep your external pages updated with the latest information.
- Use campaign tracking tags when measuring traffic from different marketing channels.

Recommendation

A proxy page that provides useful information will usually perform better than a page that only contains a button leading to an affiliate offer.

Common Mistakes to Avoid

Many beginners lose potential commissions because they overlook a few important details. Avoiding these mistakes can improve both the visitor experience and your affiliate results.

- Sending visitors directly to an affiliate offer without any explanation.
- Publishing outdated information.
- Using broken or incorrect redirects.
- Forgetting to test affiliate links after making changes.
- Providing too little information before asking visitors to click.
- Ignoring mobile users when designing landing pages.
