

How to Integrate Apple Pay on systeme.io via Stripe



Introduction

Apple Pay lets iPhone, iPad, and Mac users pay in one tap from Wallet. On systeme.io, there is no standalone Apple Pay gateway—wallet checkout is delivered **through Stripe**. Once Stripe is linked, Apple Pay is turned on in Stripe, and your checkout domain is verified, eligible buyers see the Apple Pay button on your funnel order form.

What You Need

- A systeme.io account ([plan](#) with Stripe payments)
- A **Stripe** account connected to systeme.io ([connect Stripe](#))
- Apple Pay **enabled** for your Stripe account (live mode for real sales)
- The **exact domain** customers use at checkout (systeme.io subdomain or [custom domain](#) on the funnel)
- A sales funnel with order form and Stripe-enabled offer

Step 1: Connect Stripe to systeme.io

1. Profile picture → **Settings** → **Payment gateways**
2. **Connect Stripe** and complete authorization
3. Confirm Stripe shows as connected before chasing Apple Pay

Apple Pay rides on the same Stripe payment flow as cards on systeme.io order forms—no second processor.

Step 2: Enable Apple Pay in Stripe

In the **Stripe Dashboard** (use **Live** mode for production):

1. Open **Settings** → **Payment methods** (or **Apple Pay** under Payments settings)
2. Turn on **Apple Pay**
3. **Add your checkout domain(s)**—the hostname on your published funnel URL (e.g. yourname.systeme.io or checkout.yourbrand.com)
4. Complete Stripe's **domain verification** (Stripe guides you through the Apple Pay on the Web check)

If you change domains later, add and verify each new hostname in Stripe or Apple Pay will not appear on that URL.

Google Pay can be enabled in the same Stripe payment-methods area if you want Android wallet checkout too.

Step 3: Enable Stripe on the Funnel

1. **Sites** → **Sales funnels** → your funnel
2. **Funnel settings**
3. Ensure **Stripe** is checked ([activate Stripe or PayPal](#))
4. **Save**

Publish or update your [order form](#). Apple Pay surfaces on the Stripe payment UI when the browser and device support it.

What Customers See

- **Safari** on Mac, iPhone, or iPad with Apple Pay set up in Wallet
- Supported cards in Apple Wallet tied to the Stripe-supported networks on your account

- One-tap confirm with Face ID, Touch ID, or passcode—then normal Stripe settlement in **Sales** → **Transactions**

Chrome on Windows or Android will not show Apple Pay; those users pay by card or other Stripe methods you enabled (e.g. Google Pay).

Testing Before Launch

1. Use Stripe **test mode** only for test keys—not for Apple Pay domain verification on live URLs
2. On a real Apple device, open your **live** funnel order page over **HTTPS**
3. Run a small live charge or Stripe’s recommended wallet test flow
4. Confirm the sale in systeme.io and in Stripe

Troubleshooting

No Apple Pay button

Stripe off on funnel; Apple Pay off in Stripe; domain not verified; wrong domain (www vs non-www); non-Safari browser; no card in Wallet.

Button shows but payment fails

Stripe account restrictions, currency mismatch on offer, or card issuer decline—check Stripe logs.

Works on subdomain, not custom domain

Add and verify the custom domain separately in Stripe Apple Pay settings.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I use Apple Pay without Stripe?

On systeme.io funnels, Apple Pay is integrated **via Stripe** only—not PayPal or Mollie.

Does Apple Pay work with subscriptions?

Recurring offers depend on Stripe + Apple Pay support for subscriptions on your account and region—test your subscription offer after one-time sales work.
