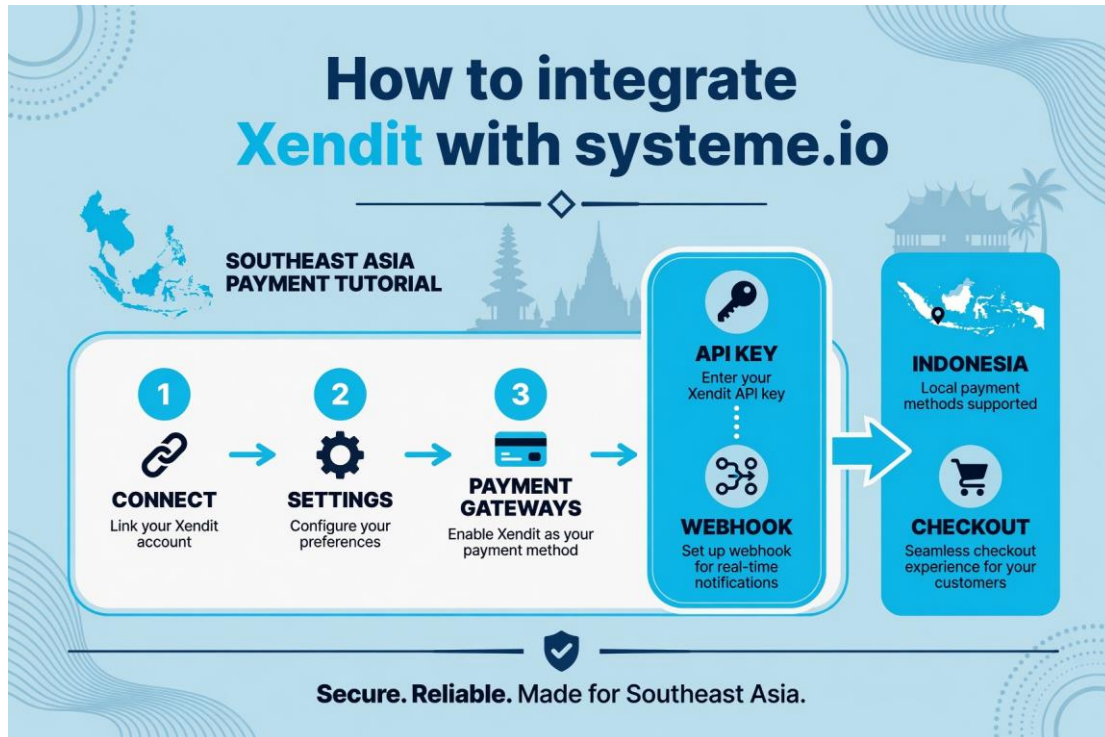


How to Integrate Xendit with systeme.io



Introduction

Xendit powers card, e-wallet, and local payment methods across **Indonesia**, **the Philippines**, and wider **Southeast Asia**. On systeme.io, Xendit is a native payment gateway: you connect production API keys and the **webhook verification token**, then enable the gateway on each sales funnel—similar in spirit to [Razorpay](#) or [Flutterwave](#).

What You Need

- A verified [Xendit](#) business account (live mode for real sales)
- A systeme.io account ([plan](#) with payment gateways)
- A sales funnel with order form and offer in a currency Xendit supports for your country

Step 1: Generate API Keys in Xendit

In the **Xendit Dashboard**, open **Settings** → **Developers** → **API Keys**.

Public API key

Copy your **Public API key**. It starts with `xnd_public`.

Secret API key

1. Click **Generate secret key** under **Secret keys**
2. Name the key (e.g. *systeme.io*)
3. Select permissions as required by Xendit for checkout—at minimum allow **Money-in** (write) and read access for balance/transactions as shown in the generator
4. Confirm with your password and **copy the secret immediately** (shown once)

Use **live** credentials when your Xendit account is in **Live mode**; test keys only for sandbox checkouts.

Step 2: Get the Webhook Verification Token

Still in Xendit: **Settings** → **Developers** → **Webhooks**.

1. Enable **auto-retry for failed webhooks** so missed events are retried
2. Click **View Webhook Verification Token**
3. Enter your password
4. Copy the token—you will paste this as **webhook secret** in *systeme.io*

This token lets systeme.io verify that payment notifications genuinely come from Xendit.

Step 3: Connect Xendit in *systeme.io*

1. Profile picture → **Settings**
2. **Payment gateways**
3. **Connect on Xendit**
4. In the popup, enter:
 - **Organization name** (your Xendit organization / business name as shown in the dashboard)
 - **Webhook secret** (verification token from Step 2)
 - **Public** and **Secret** access tokens (API keys from Step 1)
5. **Save**

If the connect screen also shows a **webhook URL** for Xendit, copy it and add it under Xendit **Developers** → **Webhooks** for the payment/invoice events your integration uses (same pattern as other gateways). Follow any URL hints shown in the systeme.io popup after save.

Step 4: Finalize Webhooks in Xendit

- Keep **auto-retry** enabled
- Ensure live-mode webhook settings match live API keys
- After a test payment, confirm the sale appears under **Sales** → **Transactions**

If money settles in Xendit but Transactions stay empty, webhook delivery is the first place to check—many sellers fix this by aligning verification token + outbound webhook URL with systeme.io's connect instructions.

Step 5: Enable Xendit on the Funnel

1. **Sites** → **Sales funnels** → your funnel
2. **Funnel settings**
3. Check **Xendit**
4. **Save**

Pair with [order form](#) and [offer](#) pricing in local currency.

Troubleshooting

Checkout fails immediately

Wrong secret/public pair, test keys in live mode, or incomplete Xendit KYC.

Paid in Xendit, no sale in systeme.io

Webhook secret mismatch; webhooks not configured; auto-retry off and one failed delivery.

Do I need Pabbly/Zapier?

Native integration should handle funnel checkout; third-party bridges are optional workarounds, not required by systeme.io's documented flow.

[Contact systeme.io support](#) with organization name, funnel URL, and Xendit payment ID (never paste secret keys in tickets).

Frequently Asked Questions

Which countries use Xendit on systeme.io?

Primarily merchants where Xendit operates—commonly Indonesia and the Philippines; confirm availability for your entity in Xendit and systeme.io gateway list.

Can I use Xendit with subscriptions?

Depends on offer type and Xendit products enabled; test recurring offers after webhooks work for one-time sales.
