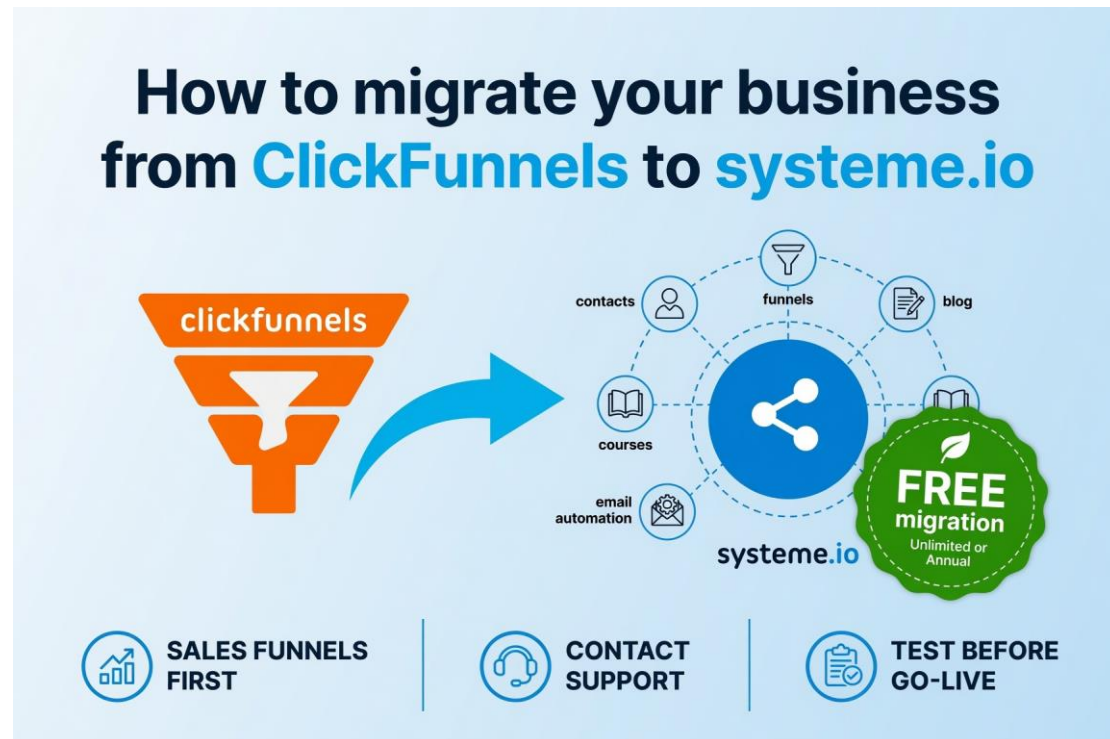


How to Migrate Your Business from ClickFunnels to systeme.io



Introduction

ClickFunnels is built for funnels—but many creators want **one login** for funnels, email, courses, checkout, and affiliates without paying for separate SMTP or stacking more tools. systeme.io documents a **complete, free business migration** from ClickFunnels when you are on the right plan (see the official guide [How to migrate your business from ClickFunnels to systeme.io](https://systeme.io/blog/how-to-migrate-your-business-from-clickfunnels-to-systeme-io)).

This guide explains **what the migration team copies**, **how the process works**, and **what you should verify** before you point your domain away from ClickFunnels.

Note from systeme.io: migration is **manually performed by their team**—not an instant automated export.

Why Move from ClickFunnels to systeme.io?

- **All-in-one stack:** funnels, unlimited email sends (plan contact limits apply), courses, payments, automations
- **0% platform transaction fees** on paid plans (see [pricing](#))
- **Affiliate program** available on every plan, including Free
- **Done-for-you migration** instead of rebuilding every page yourself

You can keep ClickFunnels live while the team builds in parallel—cancel only after testing ([free-migration](#)).

Free Migration Eligibility

Per the ClickFunnels migration guide and [How to get a free migration to systeme.io](#):

- **Unlimited monthly plan, or**
- **Any annual plan** (Startup, Webinar, or Unlimited yearly)

After subscribing, [contact support](#) and request migration from **ClickFunnels**. Share funnel URLs, read-only access or exports, and a priority list (main offer funnel first, flagship course, etc.).

What the Team Migrates (7 Areas)

1. Sales funnel pages

Funnels are usually migrated **first** so pages can go online quickly. The team rebuilds funnel steps in the systeme.io editor—layout, copy, images, videos, and audio as needed.

2. Blog pages and posts

Blog structure and posts from ClickFunnels are recreated on systeme.io's **Blog** feature (see also [When to use the sales funnel feature and the blog feature](#)).

3. Courses

Courses are imported **one by one** with attention to modules, lessons, and quizzes—core to many ClickFunnels memberships.

4. Physical products

Physical products are recreated with characteristics such as name, description, SKUs, tax, currency, price, and product images. See [How to create and sell a physical product with systeme.io](#).

5. Newsletters and campaigns

Each email in ClickFunnels—**campaigns or newsletters**—is recreated in systeme.io, preserving the intended structure and content.

6. Contact lists and tags

Lists and tags are imported into systeme.io CRM. Large or sensitive imports may require **deliverability review**—coordinate with the migration agent and authenticate your domain before big sends ([How to authenticate your domain name for email sending](#)).

7. Automations

Automations (simple or advanced) are rebuilt under **Automations** as **rules** and **workflows** matching your ClickFunnels logic where possible.

How to Request Migration from ClickFunnels

1. Create your [systeme.io](#) account and upgrade to **Unlimited monthly** or **annual** billing ([How systeme.io subscription plans are moderated](#)).
2. Open [support](#) → ask for **free migration from ClickFunnels**.
3. Provide: ClickFunnels subdomain or custom domain, admin/read-only login or exports, list of funnels, products, courses, and active automations.
4. Receive a **timeline estimate** (full migrations often take around two weeks on average—see [How to get a free migration to systeme.io](#) for typical durations; your scope may be shorter or longer).
5. Internally test checkout, opt-ins, course access, and one automation path before switching DNS.

DIY vs. Official Migration

DIY	systeme.io migration team
Export contacts CSV from ClickFunnels; import with tags	Team handles list + tag mapping
Rebuild each funnel page in the drag-and-drop editor	Team duplicates funnel pages manually
Rewrite email sequences and	Team recreates campaigns and

automations

Fast for 1 funnel; painful for full business

workflows

Included with eligible plan; queue-based timing

For a **full ClickFunnels clone**, the official [ClickFunnels → systeme.io migration](#) path is the intended solution. For a single list + one landing page, partial DIY may be enough.

Post-Migration Checklist

- ☐ Connect **Stripe** / payment gateway on systeme.io
- ☐ Authenticate domain for email ([How to authenticate your domain name for email sending](#))
- ☐ Test purchase, order bump, and thank-you page
- ☐ Enroll a test student in migrated course
- ☐ Fire a test automation (tag → email sequence)
- ☐ Update DNS / domain to systeme.io when satisfied
- ☐ Downgrade or cancel ClickFunnels subscription

Reuse and duplicate funnels later with [How to move, duplicate & delete a page from a sales funnel](#)—handy when you split offers without re-migrating.

Plan Limits Still Apply

Migration recreates assets **within your plan caps**—contacts, number of courses, funnels on Free/Startup, etc. If you migrate a large ClickFunnels account, **Unlimited** or **Webinar annual** often avoids hitting ceilings mid-project. Review [pricing](#) before opening the ticket.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is ClickFunnels migration free?

Yes with Unlimited monthly or any annual plan—no separate migration invoice.

What goes live first?

Sales funnel pages, typically, so you can start routing traffic.

Automatic import?

No—manual rebuild by the migration team.

Contacts and automations?

Yes—lists, tags, and Automations section workflows.

How do I start?

Eligible plan → [contact support](#) → share your ClickFunnels setup (see [How to get a free migration to systeme.io](#)).
